The basis for New Testament giving is “stewardship.” Stewardship indicates that the person does not own things. He is simply an administrator. God “owns the cattle on a thousand hills” (Ps. 50:10). Ps. 24:1 tells us that “the earth is the Lord’s and all it contains.” While we speak of the “owning things” (not necessarily wrong if we understand it correctly), the reality is that God has chosen to make you a caretaker of His things and asks you to administrate His affairs according to His guidelines. The problem is when people ignore their position as a steward, they tend to ignore God’s guidelines. In so doing, they use God’s things for personal pleasure. God’s resources go into their pocket in the form of things, activities, or organizations God did not intend for them to be involved with. Remember, you will stand before the Master someday and give an account (study Mt. 25 & Lk. 16).
