What is the Establishment Clause?

When the colonists came to America, the government of England had an official church, and English citizens could be punished for worshipping in any other church. The colonists' desire for religious freedom caused them to leave their home nation completely.

The first Amendment declares that the federal government cannot create an official church that everyone must support—this is, the government may not establish an official religion.

The original intent of the Constitution was never to say that school teachers cannot lead a class in prayer, only that the federal government couldn't force people to support an official state church.
