Pastors Wright and Rogers will attend the American Association of Christian Schools National Legislative Conference in DC from Monday evening through Wednesday afternoon. The conference is designed for Christian School leaders to gather for encouragement and lobbying. Under the direction of our ODACS (Old Dominion Assoc. of Church Schools) leadership, we have scheduled numerous meetings with the Senate and Congressional offices. Pastors Rogers and Wright will be part of the groups that meet with the legislative representatives. These meetings take place yearly. Pastor Wright has attended for nearly 30 years. While we often feel that government bureaucracy is problematic, it would be worse if we did not have events like this. The legislative representatives get to know people from the AACCS National Office on C St., and they get to know our ODACS representatives. Because we have developed relationships, there have been many times when we have made contact about legislation that concerns us. Some bills still pass, but we can insert language that protects our ministry. Sometimes, the legislation does not target us, but we are accidentally included. Guidelines exempting religious organizations and inserted into a bill are essential. Pray for our staff and the rest of our Virginia representatives as we meet with representatives on Wednesday.
