The evangelism and discipleship guide on Romans 12-16 is available at the information desk. Remember, these studies aim to introduce you to a new tool for winning people to Christ. Often, we think of winning someone to Christ as a one-time witnessing opportunity. The goal of the Bible study method is to utilize God's promise to use His Word to convict people. That means we rely on the Holy Spirit to do what we cannot – bring about conviction. You are asking a person to *"do a Bible study with you."* This is unobtrusive and allows the person to read God's observations of mankind's sinful condition. People must acknowledge their sinfulness and need for righteousness. In reading Rom. 3:21-5:21, a person understands that God offers faith-based righteousness. The advantage of this method is that the Scripture is guiding the discussion. You are simply reading and studying with the person. By the time a person has completed the study, you have helped them understand what God's Word says and how it applies to them. Their salvation is based on Scripture, and they have developed a habit of reading the Bible to answer questions. Chapters 12-16 are a more extended study, so begin working on the study guide early in the week.
