The Academy family and friends have been raising money for several years to replace the aging playground. The goal is \$100,000. As of January 9, we have raised \$89,445.54. In the Fall of 2024, I asked the playground company we have been consulting with to begin a formal proposal. The plan is to install a high-grade playground that will withstand heavy use – thus, the high price tag. The company has already set aside some equipment they believe will work well in our layout. It is exciting to see God providing, and I look forward to our students getting a new playground. Although the money has been given to replace the playground, we need a formal vote to proceed. We have a business meeting on January 26 to elect our church officers. In the same meeting, we will formally vote to authorize the deacons and trustees to proceed with the playground project. Once that is completed, we will consider several proposals and get the replacement on the schedule. It will be a good opportunity to review the pavilion and playground area to see if there are other changes or additions we want to include.
