Several have asked about the work projects during VBS. Last year was the first year we did some work projects as VBS was going on. It was a tremendous help. We were able to accomplish far more than I expected. This year, we have two primary projects. The first is to renovate the room across from the nursery. It will become the new copier and workroom. The second project is to renovate and complete some work in the temporary classrooms under the sanctuary. This involves putting in some sound barriers, drywall, a new wall and door, and realigning the electrical switches. Both rooms will get LED lights, saving a lot of money since these rooms are used regularly. There is a yellow sign-up sheet at the information desk. You can come for one night and for any part of the night. When we know how many people we have, we will assign people to projects.
