On Sunday, we did a preliminary report on God's financial kindness to us. Among the things we discussed was the amount our church has in savings. We have tried to be fiscally responsible so that we are not living week-to-week. The result is a healthy savings account and the ability to complete some additional projects. The loan balance as of July 13 is \$194,479, which puts us slightly ahead of our projection. Your faithful gifts have allowed us to put almost \$123,000 on the principal in the last two years. In addition, we will include two capital improvement projects in the budget. The first is \$106,000 for the playground. Our church and school family has raised the money over the past several years. The deacons and trustees approved a proposal last week. Second, there is \$35,000 for some upgrades in the sanctuary. We need to replace the pews and make a couple of changes in our displays. I appreciate your faithfulness as you live in obedience to the Lord.
